

# MULANJE MISSION HOSPITAL



Mulanje Mission Hospital is a 225-bedded rural mission hospital in Mulanje District, South Malawi, owned by the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian.

The hospital is characterized by a strong focus on preventive and primary health care and quality primary care services.

The immediate catchment area has 100,000 inhabitants. Together with the neighbouring government hospital the entire Mulanje District (pop. 685,000) is served. In addition, patients travel from neighbouring districts, Blantyre city and Mozambique.

Annual statistics:

- 2900 deliveries
- 6000 in-patient admissions
- 35,000 out-patient visits
- 72 villages reached by community programmes
