Mulanje Mission Hospital is a 237-bedded rural mission hospital in Mulanje District, South Malawi, owned by the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian.

The hospital is characterized by a focus on preventive and primary health care including community development programmes (e.g. outreach, WASH, agriculture and livelihoods).

The immediate catchment area has 100,000 inhabitants. Together with the neighbouring government hospital the entire Mulanje District (pop. 685,000) is served. In addition, patients travel from neighbouring districts, Blantyre city and Mozambique.

- 6000 in-patient admissions
- 35,000 out-patient visits
- 72 villages reached by community programmes
